Application in Standard Forms are invited for applicants who are permanent residents of Meghalaya for consideration of nomination to the 4 (four) years Bachelor of Fishery Science (BFSc) Course at the College of Fisheries, Lembucherra, Agartala, Tripura during the session 2022-23 against the State quota seat of 3 (three) numbers including 1 (one) seat for OBC category.

Eligibility Criteria:-


1. The applicants must be indigenous inhabitants or permanent residents of Meghalaya.
2. Applicants must have passed HSSLC (Science) from recognized board with minimum 45% marks in aggregate of Physics/Chemistry/Biology for ST/Physically Handicapped and 50% for OBC candidates. The applicants qualifying NEET (UG) 2022 are only eligible to apply.
3. Tribal candidates and OBC candidates should furnish attested copy of scheduled tribe certificate and non tribal candidates should submit attested copy of Permanent Residential Certificates (PRC) issued by the competent authority.
4. Applicants must have attained 16 (Sixteen) years of age on 31st August 2022 to be supported by Admit Cards/Birth Certificates. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 (Five) years in case of applicants belonging to ST/SC/OBC.

How to apply:

Applicants may submit their application forms in standard form to the Office of the Directorate of Fisheries, Fish Dale Farm, Shillong and Office of the Superintendent of Fisheries, West Garo Hills, Tura or may be mailed to megpisc@gmail.com along with all relevant documents. Shortlisted candidates will be required to bring original documents for verification during interview/counselling. Last date for submission of forms:


The last date for submission of application form complete in all respects along with NEET (UG) qualifying marks will be received at the Directorate of Fisheries, Shillong and Office of the Superintendent, Tura, West Garo Hills on the **31st August, 2022** depending on the declaration of NEET (UG) 2022 Results which may be extended to 3 (three) working days after the declaration of NEET (UG) 2022.
